
CABIN JOHN TRAIL

				Parking at CJ Local Park. Porta-john sometimes in the parking lot. Restroom at Clara Barton Community Center (check hours). Walk across the one lane bridge to the trailhead on the other side down to the C&O canal. Walk along the canal and cross the footbridge onto the C&O towpath and turn left. You will see the trail on the right as you approach the creek. It meanders in the woods down to the river.
